Hornets "AAA": 2019-20 Season Information

Building on the success of our current 2004 U14 team which is ranked #4 in the country and heading to the USA Hockey National Tournament in South Bend, IN, we are excited to announce our plans for next season for this age group. **The 2004 Birth Year Hornets Team 1** will be designated "Tier 1" and will compete against some of the best teams in North America. This group will practice multiple times a week, Team practices will focus on the skills and team concepts to continue the development of our players as they enter a very important time in their hockey development process. The team information is as follows:

- League Independent AAA
- **Practice** Two weeknight practices, once in a skill based shared ice session, and once on full ice as a team. In addition, weekend days where games are not scheduled practices will be held giving each player a minimum of 4 ice sessions per week.
- **High School Friendly** We encourage our players to compete on their school teams if they choose. As an organization, we believe kids at this age should be afforded the opportunity to experience the fun environment High School Hockey provides, allowing them to compete for their school in front of classmates and parents.
- **Game Schedule** Per the USA Hockey guidelines, a schedule of approximately 55-60 games against the highest level of competition. Game scheduling has already begun and will be published this summer to allow families the opportunity to plan accordingly for home and road games.
- Tournaments this team will compete in several high-level tournaments including

 - Mo-Town Classic (Detroit, MI)
 - o Harbor Town Tournament in Buffalo, NY

- Skater Season Fee \$2,200
- Goalie Season Fee \$500
 - Note: goalies will receive a \$750 stipend for goalie instruction, instructors are at the discretion of the team and player
- **National Bound** this team will attempt to qualify for the Mid-Am Tier "1" Tournament in the hopes of advancing to the National Championships in the Spring of 2020. This National Bound team will be a highly competitive team with the intent of competing against some of the best teams in North America.

Space for these is limited, and so we will hold spots based on a first come – first serve basis.
